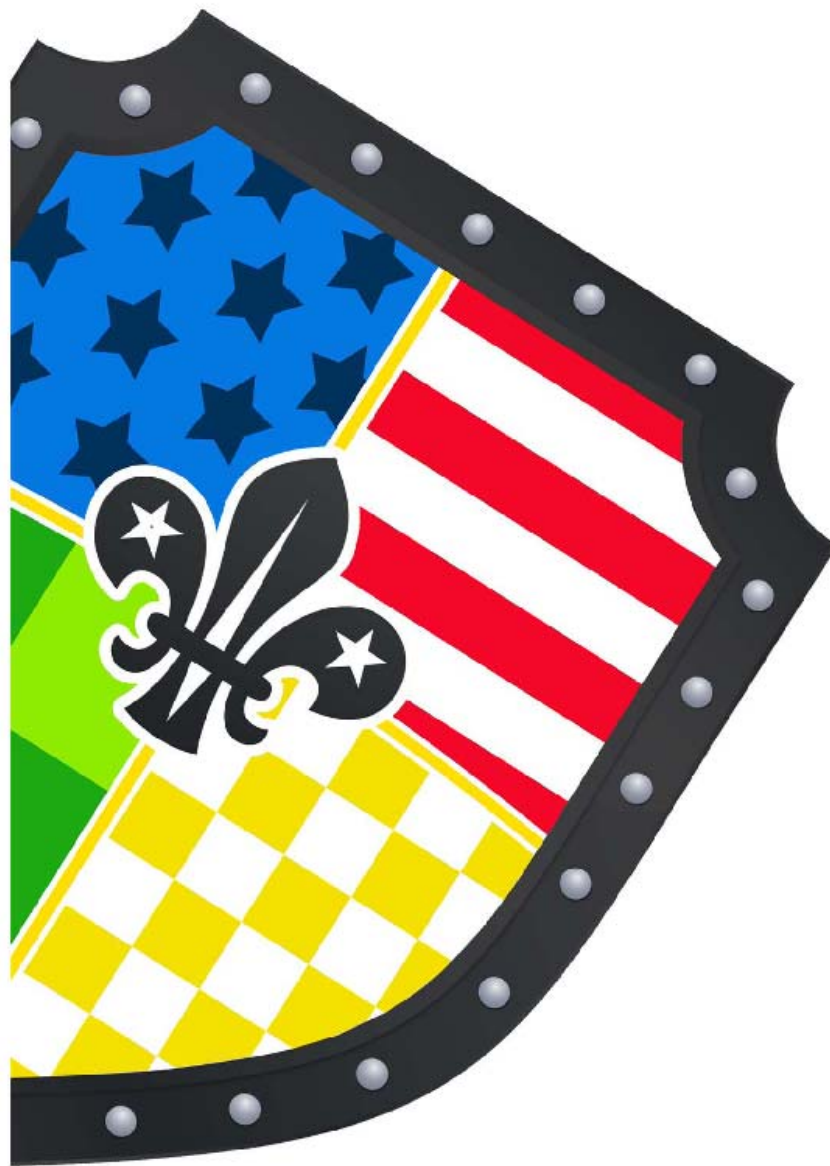

### **Chamboree 2010 International Jamboree**

Sat 31<sup>st</sup> July – Sat 7<sup>th</sup> August 2010

*Cheshire is ready to welcome the World*

***\*Cub Camp (Fri 30<sup>th</sup> July – Sun 1<sup>st</sup> August) \* Beaver Day on Sun 1<sup>st</sup> August***

#### ***Venue***

Cheshire Agricultural Showground, Tabley, Nr Knutsford. The site is 5 minutes from junction 19, M6.

#### ***It's for You***

Chamboree 2010 looks forward to welcoming members of the Scout and Guide movements from around the world aged 10½ - 18 with their Adult Leaders and Helpers. You can expect to be amongst 3000+ campers from Cheshire, around the UK and from various parts of the World. On the first weekend numbers will be swelled as we welcome Cub Scouts from the local area (limited places are available for UK Cub Scouts from outside Cheshire). Beavers from Cheshire will join the camp for one day on Sunday 1<sup>st</sup> August.

#### ***Dates***

The site will open for Chamboree campers on Saturday 31<sup>st</sup> July 2010 and close on Saturday 7<sup>th</sup> August 2010. Our “opening ceremony” will be held in the evening of Saturday 31<sup>st</sup> July and the closing ceremony will be held on Friday evening (6<sup>th</sup> August). The site will open for Cubs on Friday 30<sup>th</sup> July and there will be an opportunity for all local Groups to pitch tents on Thursday 29<sup>th</sup> July.

#### ***Activities***

You can expect an exciting package of activities at Chamboree including one day off-site at our water activities centre in the grounds of Tatton Park (about 15 minutes from the Chamboree site). Back on-site there will be a range of challenging, exciting and unusual activities to keep you motivated. Check the website for latest details. There will also be a full programme of evening activities including live bands, disco's and special challenges.

#### ***Equipment***

Each Group is expected to provide all its own tents and equipment. Cooking must be done on gas stoves only - open fires are not permitted.

## ***Camp Fee***

The cost is only £139 for campers aged 10½ - 18 and £80 for leaders staying on the site. Discounts for early payment are available. The fee includes all camping fees, a sub-camp scarf, camp handbook and all activities. The reduced fee for adults does not include daytime activities although they will be welcome to take up any spare places if they have the time!

The fees exclude food and transport other than transport to off-site activities. A non-refundable deposit of £10 per person is required to secure places with cheques payable to Chamboree 2010 or you can pay direct into our bank account (Barclays Bank, Middlewich, Sort Code: 20-24-09, Account: Chamboree 2010, Account No: 43350320) and don't forget to quote your group name. The final date for bookings is 1<sup>st</sup> March 2010 with final payments due by 1<sup>st</sup> May 2010, however, once the number of bookings reaches 4,000 we will unfortunately have to turn people away.

## ***Discount***

A £10 discount on fees is available for those who pay the full fee before 1<sup>st</sup> March 2010, this means that camper's aged 10½ - 18 will only pay £129 and Leaders will only pay £70.

## Activities – Brief Overview

### Skill Zone

Linking in with the theme of the 22<sup>nd</sup> World Scout Jamboree in Sweden 2011 this is a truly back to basics zone with Pioneering, Backwoods, Turks heads and more! Half a day is spent here.

### Action Zone

A full day action zone for the adrenaline junkie offering both on-land and on-water activities at Cheshire Scouts water activity centre in the magnificent Tatton Park!

### Urban Zone

A haven for the Urban Scout with skate boarding, BMX, graffiti and music. Half a day is spent here.

### Global Zone

A chance to learn about different cultures, try their food and experience some of the day to day difficulties of Scouts from around the world. This is a full day zone, split into two halves.

### Power Zone

Aim and fire is the theme of this base giving you the chance to shoot rifles, try your hand at golf, archery and quasar shooting! Half a day is spent here.

### Energy Zone

Got energy to unleash? This is the place for you, at the Fun capital of Chamboree with crazy games, a circus and more! Half a day is spent here.

### Olympia Zone

A special zone devised just for 2010, become a Chamboree Olympian right on-site, test your sporting skills and energy levels to the max. Half a day is spent here.
